# Mode of action

Alphachloralose is a hypnotic (nervous system depressant and convulsant). It acts as a sleep aid in causing the mice to sleep by slowing their cardiac system. The rodent falls into hypothermia and then dies. The action is fast: 24 hours after ingestion of the bait.

# Active Capsulation Technology

BLACK PEARL PASTA is a paste bait containing micro-encapsulated Alphachloralose. This innovative process enhances palatability and ensures intelligent release of the poison to its target for a fast-acting, lethal effect.

#### Dosage

For high infestation: 5g to 20g of bait in a mouse bait station every 3m.

For low infestation: 5g to 20g bait in a mouse bait station every 5m.

## Instructions for use

Place baits safely to prevent access by children and non-targeted animals.

Preferably place baits in suitable bait boxes, appropriate containers, under a curved tile, or in a piece of tubing. Regularly check bait consumption and replace consumed or soiled bait, until the consumption has stopped.

At the end of the treatment, remove baits and materials and dispose of them safely. Clean the bait stations with a rag and throw it in the household dustbin. Repeat the treatment in case of a new infestation, new tracks, or fresh droppings.

#### Disposal

Dead rodents and bait found outside bait points should be disposed of while using protective gloves. Remove all baits after treatment. Dispose of them in accordance with local regulations.

### Precautions for use

Bait stations containing BLACK PEARL PASTA must be labeled with the following information:

Do not open the box. Keep out of reach of children. Store away from food and beverages, including those intended for animals. In case of exposure, immediately contact a poison control center (ORFILA: +33(0)1 45 42 59 59), emergency services, or a doctor, and describe the situation (provide label details and assess the exposure dose). Meanwhile, pending further advice: Inhalation: Move to fresh air and rest. Skin contact: Remove contaminated clothing,

Inhalation: Move to fresh air and rest. Skin contact: Remove contaminated clothing, wash skin with soap, and rinse thoroughly with water. Do not use solvents or thinners. Eye contact: Rinse thoroughly under a gentle stream of water (lukewarm if possible) for several minutes while keeping eyelids open under the water stream. Ingestion: Immediately consult a doctor and show the packaging or label. Do not induce vomiting. Regardless of the amount ingested, do not eat or drink. Place the victim in a lateral safety position and protect them from injury in case of sudden movements or convulsions. Monitor breathing. Follow medical advice. In case of severe distress, contact 15 (or 112). Advice for doctors: Contains a nervous system depressant and convulsant rodenticide. Early bronchial congestion may occur. Treatment is symptomatic; there is no specific antidote.
