## Regulatory information

<b>Targeted organism</b>	Black rats ( <i>Rattus rattus</i> ) Brown rats ( <i>Rattus norvegicus</i> ) House mice ( <i>Mus musculus</i> )
<b>Application</b>	Use indoors and outdoors, around buildings, in open areas and landfills.

## Mode of action

Difenacoum is a second-generation anticoagulant. Rodents die from internal bleeding. The first symptoms appear a few hours after ingestion, and death occurs on average 4 to 10 days later.

## Instructions for use

The product should be used in secure bait stations or covered and protected bait points.

**Against rats :** 90 to 100 g of product spaced 5 to 10 meters apart.  
**Against mice :** 20 to 30 g of product spaced 3 to 5 meters apart.

Against rats in open areas and outdoor dumps :  
90 to 100 g of product per bait point spaced 5 to 10 meters apart or directly into burrows. Cover or block burrow entrances where the bait is placed to reduce the risk of the bait being removed or dispersed.

Inspecter les postes après 2 à 3 jours (souris) et 5 à 7 jours (rats) pour vérifier que l'appât est consommé, puis une fois par semaine. Les produits ne doivent pas être utilisés au-delà de 35 jours sans évaluation du statut de l'infestation et de l'efficacité du traitement.

## Packaging

10g sachets - 5kg bucket  
10 g sachets - 5 kg box

## Disposal

Search for and dispose of dead rodents during treatment, at a minimum every time bait stations are inspected. Dispose of dead rodents in accordance with local regulations. After treatment is complete, dispose of uneaten bait and packaging in an appropriate collection system.

## Safety instructions

For alternate use, consider using a non-anticoagulant rodenticide, if available, or a more potent anticoagulant. If, after a 35-day treatment period, baits continue to be consumed and no reduction in rodent activity is observed, the cause should be determined.
